Giant Organizer for Catan, 4 Main Expansions, and Their Extensions

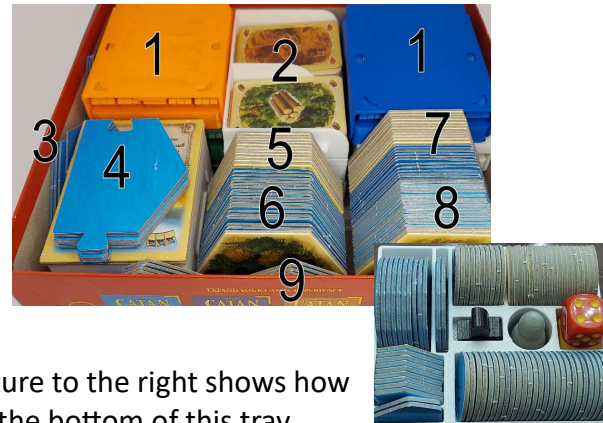
This organizer for Catan, Seafarers, Cities & Knights, Traders & Barbarians, and Explorers & Pirates, along with all of their extensions fits into just 3 Catan boxes. The third box also has room for the Dragons expansion organizer. The full instructions for this one are included separately. This organizer uses the same player trays and card trays as the others. All pieces from this organizer are available individually as well.



Catan + Seafarers + 5/6 Player Extension Organizer

Below you can see how to arrange everything in the box. SF=Seafarers

The remaining 2 Seafarers Frame Pieces go on top of the trays. The picture to the right shows how everything is arranged in the accessories tray. The chit tray attaches to the bottom of this tray.

Put 2 flip charts on the hexes holder/card tray on the right and the barbarian tile/longest road/largest army over the other card tray.



Catan + SF + C&K Player Trays/Traders & Barbarians + Explorers & Pirates

Player Tray: The tray to the left shows the Catan/SF/C&K player pieces layout, and the right is for E&P/T&B. Slide the respective Building Costs Cards into the lid to ensure pieces don't fall out when the lid is closed. **The tray may be a little tough to open at first, but will become easier over time.** You can file down the nubs on the side to speed up the process, but just a tiny bit at a time. To open it, the tabs at the front need to be pulled away from the tray slightly. These are the same trays that come with the organizers above. Custom colored trays and matching player pieces are available as well.





Catan Resource Card Tray: This tray holds the resource and development cards for Catan or the cards from Cities & Knights. They slide into cascading formation during play, and then slide into a vertically stacked formation for easy storage. It can also rest on its back so that the cards sit vertically.

Traders, Dragons, & Adventurers Scenario Organizer: This organizer can be used standalone, but can also be placed in the third box of the Giant Organizer. Everything is arranged according to the picture to the left, and there is a place for the 2 frame pieces to sit on top. It will fit into the TDA box.



Custom Colored Player Pieces for Catan and the Expansions: These pieces look nearly identical to the game pieces, but available in a variety of colors for the base game, Seafarers, Cities & Knights, Traders & Barbarians, and Explorers and Pirates.



Ticket to Ride Player Trays: These trays have a lid that flips open and has a place for cards allowing you to clearly see all your destination tickets at a glance. The player pieces go in the tray which fits into the insert that was included with the game. Some of the lids might have more or less resistance when opening and closing. Due to tight tolerances, some trays may be easier to open than others, but makes no difference in how the trays are used.



Ticket to Ride Card Tray: This tray is available in 2 sizes, a small one for the original game, and a larger one for expansions, like Ticket to Ride: Europe and many others. The destination tickets go into the shorter card holder, the train cards in the larger one, with the discard pile in the middle. The face-up cards go in the 5 angled spots, which are designed to make it easier to grab the cards. There is also space under the destination tickets to store the extra trains that come with the game. If you take the insert out of the box, you can fit this tray, the board, and player trays above into the box.



Disney Villainous Card Tray: This card tray fits in the box and holds the player cards and board. When expanded, it more than doubles in length so it can hold the opened board. When you open or close the tray, **lay the tray on a flat surface**. Opening or closing it while holding it in your hands, can cause it to bend or break.

Splendor Organizer: A small tray for the Spice Road expansion is also available now. It will fit into the main organizer which holds all the pieces from Splendor and the Cities of Splendor expansion. All 3 expansions fit securely into one box with room left over to possibly fit a future expansion. The tokens tray is a separate piece so you can use it while playing. The square noble tiles have a space for them under the rectangular noble tiles from Cities of Splendor. The "Route to the Orient" board sits on top of everything.



Catan Base Game Player Trays: This tray is for those that want a compact tray for only the base game. It is just slightly larger than the building costs card and they can be stacked on top of each other for easy storage. The building cost card is used as a lid, and held in place with a clip that can be attached to the bottom and the costs card placed in the slot while playing. I recommend this tray for anyone who doesn't plan on buying any expansions.
