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Catan Organizer Instructions

Hello, thank you for purchasing this organizer. I hope it makes your game more enjoyable. These instructions should help you place everything in the correct place. And of course, if you need any help, or have any suggestions, you can always email me at simit3dprints@gmail.com

Note: Some lids will be a little tight at first and will get better with use. The lids stay shut with a small nub that slips into a small hole, so if you want, you can lightly file that nub. Also, keep in mind that the lids are designed in a way that they will stay put when stored in the box. Please don't hold the boxes upside down and shake them to see how secure it is unless you want to clean up a mess \bigcirc .

Base = Catan base game, SF = Seafarers, CK = Cities & Knights, TB = Traders & Barbarians, EP = Explorers & Pirates. A '+' refers to a 6 player extension.

Player Trays – The pictures to the right show the layout of the player pieces. The cost cards go into the lid from the bottom. There's a small chance that the pieces don't fit. In about 1 of 150 sets, the pieces are much larger than normal. Please email me if that happens.





Card Trays – One large tray holds the Base cards, and the other holds CK. The smaller tray will hold the TB cards.

Hexes Holder – This tray has embossed lettering that shows which hexes go into each spot.

Frame Pieces Holder – This holds the normal sized frame pieces. It holds 11 of the longer pieces, with a separate notch for the 2 that are shaped a little differently, 6 medium, and 10 small.



Accessories Trays – There are

multiple trays that hold various pieces. The pictures below show where everything goes. In the left picture, the fish tokens are on the left, and commodity tokens are on the right with a spot for the boot. The other tray holds pieces as shown.





The numbers in the picture to the right indicate the less obvious items.

- 1. Starting at "1" and going down: 18 Base numbers, 10 SF numbers, 12 EP numbers, 4 CK Metropolis tokens (1 is a spare), and one empty space for spares.
- 6 EP Pirate Lair Tokens with 2 more horizontally above them from EP+
- 3. Base docks with 2 more above it from Base+
- 4. Base+ numbers with EP+ below
- 5. SF and SF+ Harbors

Boxes – Now it's time to put all this into the boxes. I recommend watching the video I mentioned earlier.

- 1. The 2 tier card tray, and then the chits/fish token tray on top.
- 2. Base/CK/SF Player Trays
- 3. Both 3 tier card trays. You can put the longest road/largest army, harbormaster, and barbarian tracker card on top.
- 4. The camels/fish/spices/etc tray on its side.
- 1. TB/EP player trays
- 2. Put the poor/wealthy settler tokens between the player trays and frame pieces.
- 3. Frame pieces holder
- 4. 2 CK booklets next to frame pieces, and 4 more on the right side next to the hexes.
- 5. Between the player trays and hexes, place the EP scenario cards, mission cards, and victory point cards (3 of each).
- 6. Hexes holder.
- 7. 8 Fish Chevrons tuck in under the frame pieces.

The 3rd box simply holds all the irregular frame pieces and the last tray. You can use the Explorers & Pirates 6 player extension box since it is smaller. Just put the 2 largest pieces(C1 and C2 from EP) in the box, and put the last accessories tray in the corner on top. Then on the other half, place the rest of the frame pieces. If you have Traders, Dragons, & Barbarians, then that can be placed in here as well.
